#### Introduction

We take care of funding for the arts in Wales.



We need to manage our funding in a way that helps make sure **everyone** has the chance to be involved in the arts.



We also want there to be more people from these **groups** on our staff team.



We are a charity. This means our work is checked by a **board of governors**. We want people from the **groups** to be on the **board of governors** too.



We want to employ someone to help make all these changes. If you think this person could be you, we would like to hear from you.



## What the job is about

This job is called the **Agent for Change**.



As the **Agent for Change** you will use what you know and your own experiences to:



 be able to see how and when people are not being treated fairly



- say **what** needs to be done to change this



 and help make sure changes happen within the Arts Council for Wales.



You will understand and use the experiences of people from the **groups**.



You will support our staff to make changes.



Here are some of the things we would like you to do:



1. Make sure our work is easier to find, use and understand for the **groups of people**. For example, this could mean making sure our plans are in different languages.



2. Work with groups in Wales who don't have enough say in the arts. And who have had bad experiences.

3. Work with the Welsh Government.



4. Help make our staff team more diverse.

**Diverse** means people from different backgrounds and with different needs.



5. Support us to write new goals.



6. Help make sure our staff get the right training.



7. Help us find the best ways to check the work we do.

You will be passionate about equality and treating people fairly.




You will want to make a big difference to the arts in Wales.

We understand that it will take time for changes to be made. That is why the job will be for 2 or 3 years.



We are open to talking about how the job could be done.



You will work with our Council members often.



You will report to our Chief Executive.



The salary for this job is £59,269.



We will talk more about how the job can be done when we offer the job to someone.



The person who gets the job will be chosen by a group of people from different backgrounds and with different needs.



They will be look at what experience you have that could help you do the 7 things we would like you to do listed on pages 7 and 8.

- How you think the job should be done
