All answers need to be submitted on to the online application form and cannot be accepted as an attached document.

Log in to <https://portal.arts.wales/> to submit your **Experiment** application.

Contacting you

When you log into the application you will need to tell us who we need to contact and what language we should contact them in.

This will include:

- The portal admin contact (the person who has the login details and manages applications submitted on portal.arts.wales – it's usually the person who manages the finance too!)
- Headteacher
- The designated teacher for your enquiry

You will also need to provide the 7-digit school code for your school (Please check on <https://mylocalschool.gov.wales/> if you're not sure what your school code is).

In your application, you will need to answer the following questions:

1. Please provide a short description, outlining why your school is interested in taking part in Experiment? Please include why now is the right time for your school to take part in the Experiment programme.
(max. 250 words)
2. What challenges or opportunities within your school's development plan would you like to focus on through this enquiry?
(max. 250 words)
3. Which area/s do you anticipate focusing your enquiry on?
Literacy Development / Health and Wellbeing / Creative Learning across the curriculum

Briefly explain why you've chosen this area and how it connects to your school's current priorities.
(max. 250 words)

4. Please tell us about the designated teacher that will lead this enquiry – this should be someone who is available for planning conversations, a keen advocate for driving forward change and able to create flexibility in their timetable to engage fully with the programme.

What is their role in the school, which cohort of learners will they work with and why are they well placed to lead this enquiry?
(max. 250 words)

5. You will need to **tick a box** to confirm that your headteacher supports the designated teacher to commit to the following if successful:
- Attending one compulsory training day
(North – 14 Jan / Mid – 20 Jan / South 22 Jan).
 - Leading the enquiry with one class or learner group.
 - Engaging fully with the Creative Learning Partner.
